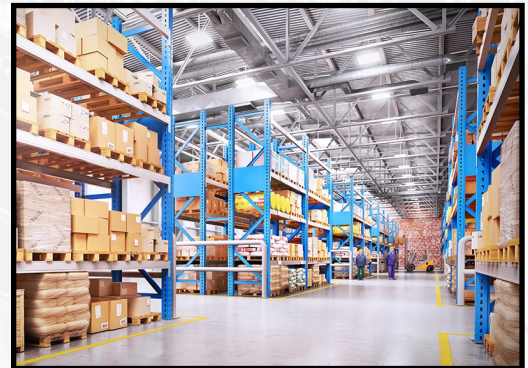
**What: Warehouse Assistant Manager**

- 5+ years of related warehouse experience required

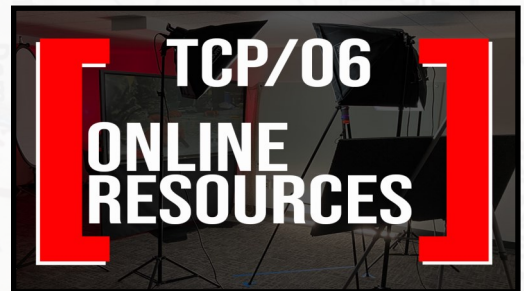


## **Employment Readiness**
