What: Heavy Equipment Operator

Operate trucks in the loading, hauling and unloading of various equipment and materials. Work with a crew to excavate and backfill ditches and trenches. Assist in the installation and maintenance of piping systems. Operate construction or power equipment such as an excavator, dozer, dump truck, backhoe, telehandler and front end loader.

Bonus! Housing available on a 200 acre property with an 80 acre reservoir.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Valid/current CDL A
- HSD/GED or one to three years related experience or training
- Basic math e.g. add, multiply, divide or whole numbers and fractions

Employment Readiness

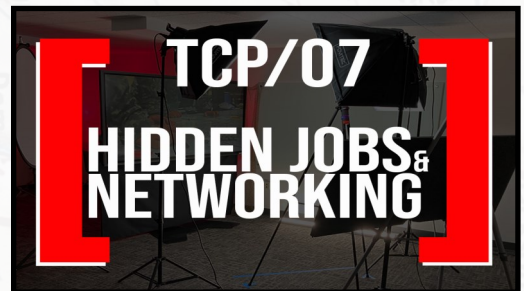

The Jobs for Veterans' State Grant (JVSG) is 100% federally funded through the U.S. department of Labor, Veterans' Employment and Training Service (USDOL-VETS). This grant is part of an award grant totaling \$2,429,678 with 0% financed from non-government sources.

The JVSG provides federal funding for individualized career and training-related services to Veterans and eligible persons with significant barriers to employment. The grant also provides funding to conduct outreach to the business community and engage in advocacy efforts to increase employment opportunities to Veterans.
