



OTI's Energy Conservation and Weatherization Internship

OTI's paid internship program provides participants training and hands-on experience in the weatherization field. During the 6-11week program, interns build skills, gain valuable in-the-field experience, secure certificates and earn wage hikes as they progress through the following 3 phases:

Phase I (6 weeks): Onboarding, in-house training and then hands-on supervised work with a contractor.

Starting wage: \$18.20.

- **Certifications:** OSHA 10, Lead-Based Paint Renovator, Health & Safety Mold and Moisture.

Successful interns will be invited to participate in Phase II.

Phase II (1 week): Intensive retrofit installer training.

Wage increase to: \$20.70

- **Certifications:** REA Retrofit Installer for Mobile Homes; REA Retrofit Installer for Stick-Built Homes

Successful interns will be invited to participate in Phase III.

Phase III (4 weeks): Energy auditor job shadowing, mentoring, training and testing.

Wage increase to: \$23.00

- **Certification:** REA Energy Analyst
