Our Landscape Training Program offers participants a no-cost intensive six-week curriculum with classroom learning sessions and weekly hands-on practicum.

Our "essentials" course is an excellent way to learn the fundamentals and advanced techniques of landscaping. By participating in this six-week program, Trainees will receive a \$1,400 stipend and a Non-credited Certificate (NCC) through Chemeketa Community College.
